*Policy for DS Courses

- All questions will be set in Sanskrit Language with Devnagari Script.
- ❖ 60% of Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 1st and 2ndSemester(1st Year).
- * 80% of Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 3rd and 4th Semester(2nd Year).
- * 100% Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 5th to 8th Semester(3rd Year & 4th Year).

*Policy for other than DS Courses

- * All questions will be set in Sanskrit Language with Devnagari Script.
- * 20% of Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 1st and 2nd Semester (1st Year).
- * 30% of Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 3rd Semester(2nd Year).
- ❖ 40% Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 7thSemester(4th Year).
